- Financially support our new Contemporary Music Ministries



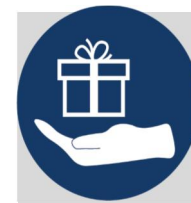
## CONNECT

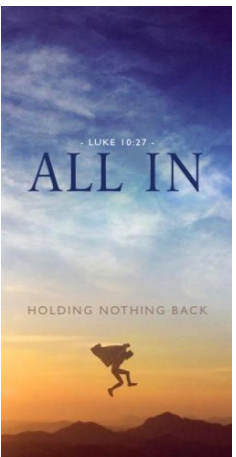
## SERVE
